 - Imidacloprid treatment for lightly to moderately infested trees: \$1.00 - \$4.00 per inch of trunk diameter
 - Safari treatment for heavily infested trees: \$3.00 - \$9.00 per inch of trunk diameter
 - Price may be decreased for a higher number of trees or increased for more difficult terrain.
 - Normally there is no charge for inspection, consultation, or estimate. Ask about any minimum charge.

- You can purchase Imidacloprid or Dinotefuran treatment products through any of the vendors listed on the [Contacts](#) page of the web site. When you call, indicate the total number of diameter inches to be treated. For Imidacloprid, we recommend that you specify a “**generic Imidacloprid 75% WSP in 1.6 oz packaging for treating the hemlock woolly adelgid.**” Then the store can tell you the appropriate product and amount to buy.
