Purchasing Hemlocks

Please ...

- **Don't** dig hemlocks from public lands such as national forests or state parks.
- **Don't** bring hemlocks home from areas that may be infested with adelgids.
- **Do** purchase hemlocks from reputable growers or retailers who can verify that they are not infested with adelgids or have already been treated.
- **Do** watch over your new hemlocks for signs of adelgids. If you detect an infestation, call the Hemlock Help Line 706-429-8010 and plan to take immediate action to deal with the problem.
