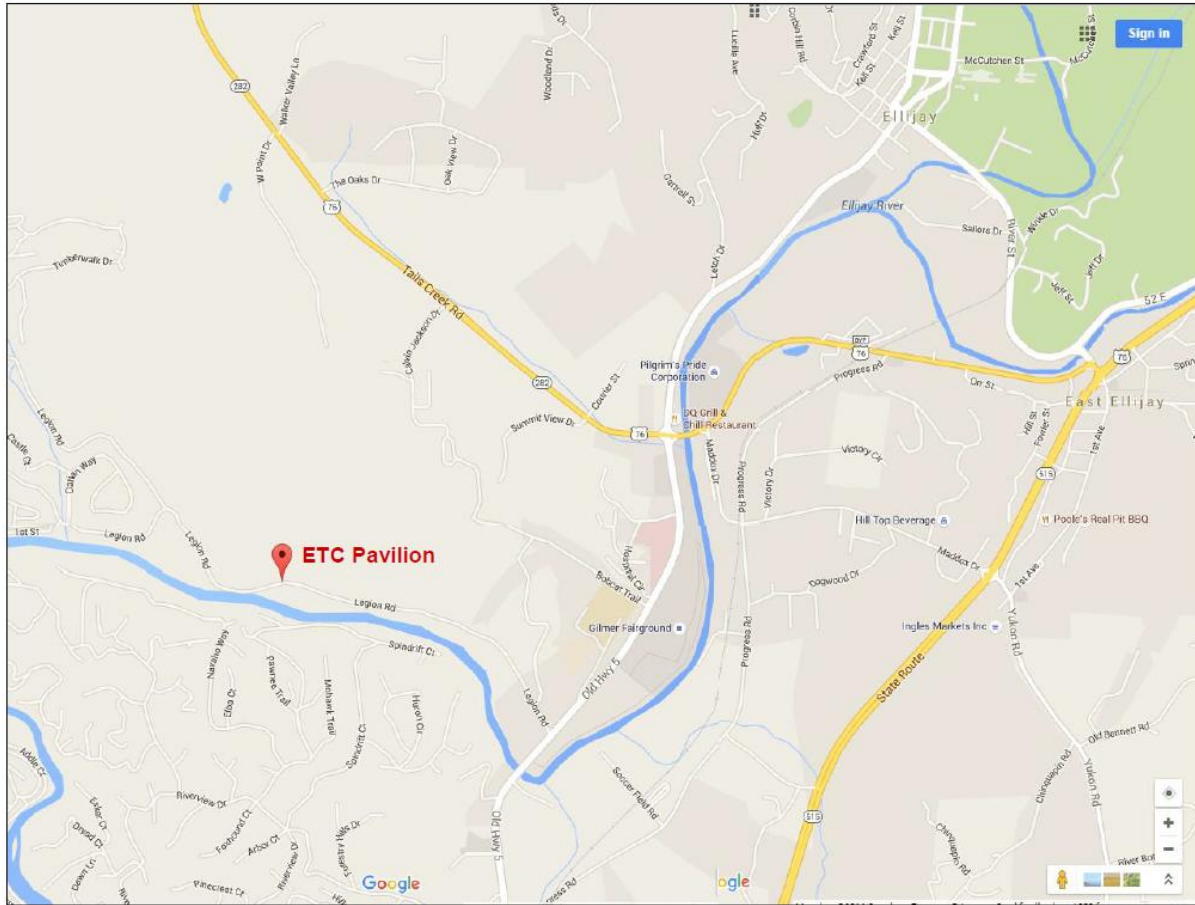

EXHIBITORS:

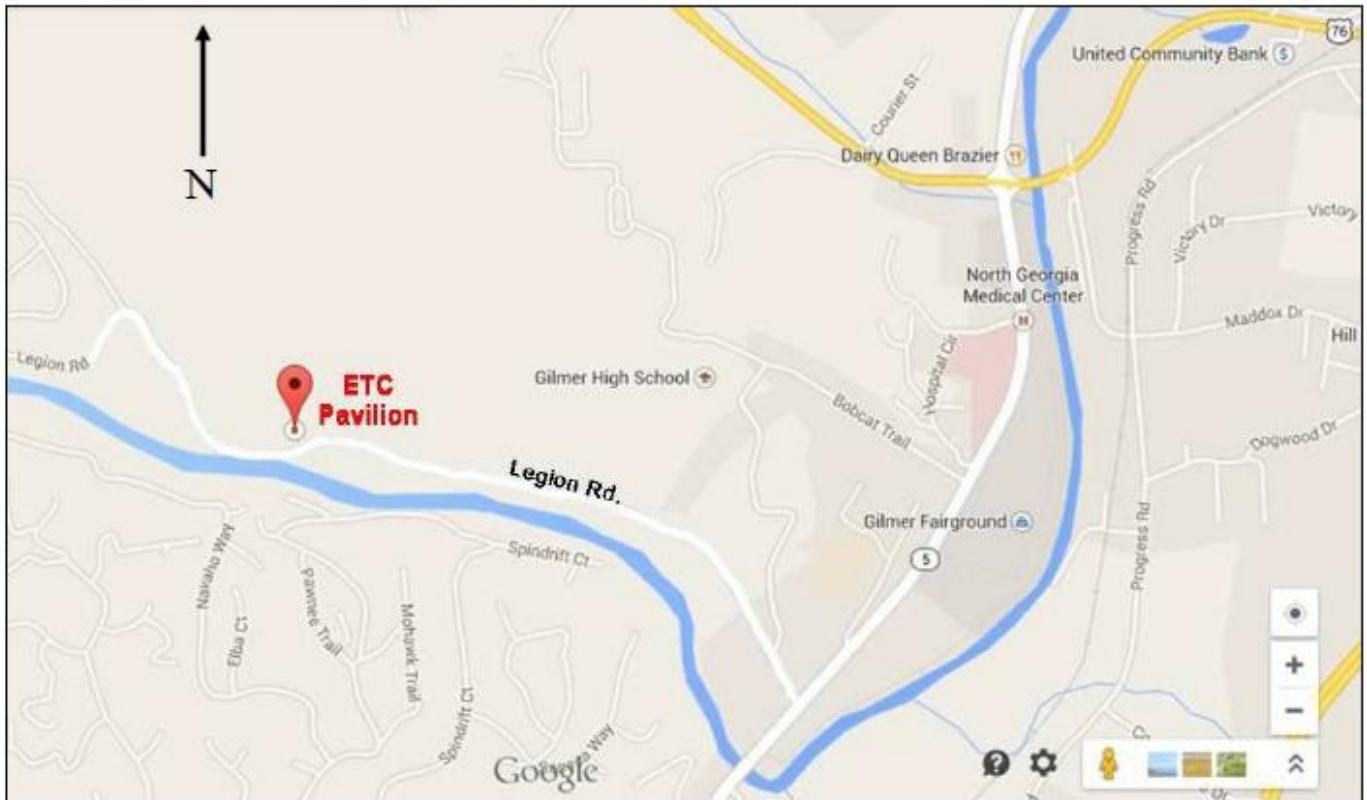
- * You may start set-up as early as 8 a.m., but please plan to arrive no later than 9 a.m. Check in at the SGH Welcome Station at the far end of the parking area. You may drive to your booth site long enough to unload and then move your vehicle to the parking area before 10 a.m.
- * Each booth site is approximately 10' x 15', but larger sites can be provided if you let us know what you need. Booth spaces will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. Bring your own tent or canopy and whatever you need to secure it in case of wind, tables for your display, handouts, and other materials, folding chairs optional for your exhibit staff.
