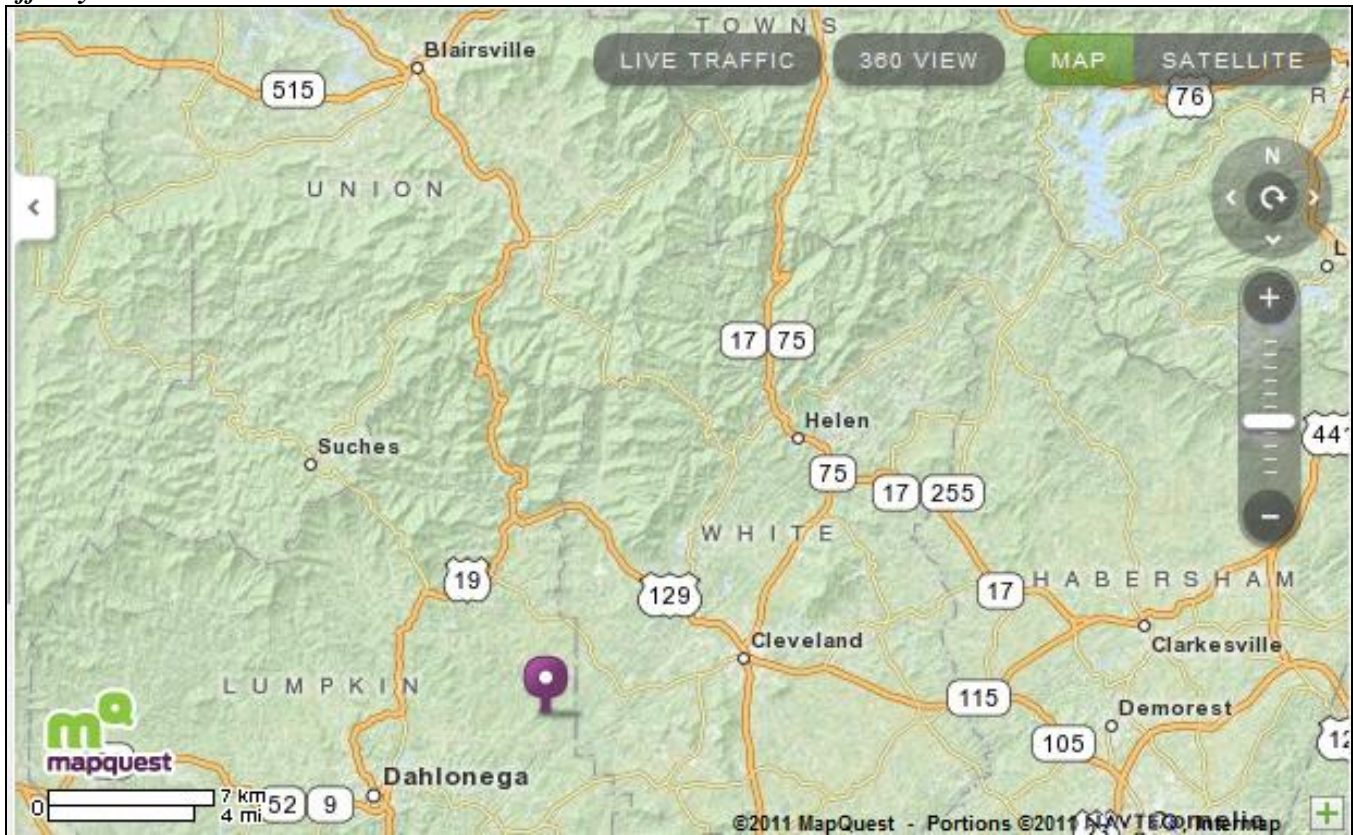


Directions to Frog Hollow, 956 Frog Hollow Rd. (between Dahlonega & Cleveland)

Updated 4/16/11

NOTE: There are 2 roads called Frog Hollow in Lumpkin County. Be sure you navigate to the one that runs off Roy Grindle Rd.



From Dahlonega:

- From Highway 60N take Cavender Creek Rd. and travel east 4 miles.
- Turn left onto Town Creek Church Rd. and go 1.8 miles.
- Just after crossing the Chestatee River, turn right onto Roy Grindle Rd.
- At .8 mile, turn right onto Frog Hollow Rd.
- Almost at the end of the road, you'll come to #956. It's a farm with a red-roofed barn beside the Chestatee River.

From Cleveland:

- Take Highway 115 (W. Kytle St) and travel west 1.6 miles.
- Turn right onto Town Creek Rd. and go 4.3 miles.
- Bear left onto Eli Knob Rd. and go .9 mile.
- At the stop sign, turn right onto Longleaf Dr. which becomes Roy Grindle Rd.
- After less than 1 mile, left onto Frog Hollow Rd.
- Almost at the end of the road, you'll come to #956. It's a farm with a red-roofed barn beside the Chestatee River.

From Blairsville:

- Take Highway 129 south and go 20.7 miles.
- At Turner's Corner, turn right onto Highway 19 and go 2.2 miles.
- Turn left onto Damascus Church Rd. and go 3.8 miles.
- At the White County line, Damascus Church becomes Town Creek Rd. Continue on Town Creek Rd. 1.5 miles.
- Turn sharply right onto Eli Knob Rd. and go .9 mile.
- At the stop sign, turn right onto Longleaf Dr. which becomes Roy Grindle Rd.
- After less than 1 mile, left onto Frog Hollow Rd.
- Almost at the end of the road, you'll come to #956. It's a farm with a red-roofed barn beside the Chestatee River.
