Notice:	>Group size will be limited to 10 SGH volunteers plus the project leader so please sign up early.
	<b>9:00 a.m.</b> – SGH volunteers arrive and report to Donna Shearer. You'll be organized into small teams for planting 20 hemlock saplings receive planting instructions, and have a planting demo. Other volunteers will be working in separate teams to plant other kinds of trees and shrubs.
	<b>9:30 a.m.</b> – Hemlock Helpers will receive your equipment and supplies, be directed to your planting site, and begin planting trees.
	<b>Noon</b> – All teams will come together for a group picnic. After lunch we'll resume planting if not already finished.
Schedule:	<b>By 3:30 p.m</b> . (or sooner if finished) – We'll stop work, clean up, and then head for home, or feel free to explore this beautiful part of Atlanta.
Terrain:	The terrain at the project site is relatively flat to moderately rolling. We'll make sure everyone is assigned to a work site where you can be safe and comfortable.
What to Wear:	Dress for the weather and the activity, including <b>long pants and long sleeves, sturdy footgear</b> with socks, work gloves, and rain gear in case of light rain.
	Pack a sack lunch, personal water bottle and a camera if you like. Also bring work gloves and a pointed shovel and/or mattock if you have them. Be sure your tools are marked with your name of initials.
What to Bring:	We'll provide some snacks and extra bottled water. If you have any serious allergies (like bee stings), bring whatever you need to manage.
Don't Bring	This is an environmentally friendly, pack-it-in pack-it-out event, so please don't bring any glass or styrofoam items. Also, as much as we love dogs, please don't bring them this time.
